What is Test Improvement?

- **Ensure commitment and buy-in**
It is essential to obtain and retain commitment from everyone.
- **Set realistic goals**
What can and must be achieved, when and by what means?
- **Perform an assessment**
Get insight into the strengths and improvement possibilities.
- **Define improvement actions**
Translate the goals and assessment result into short and long term improvement actions.
- **Plan and implement**
A pragmatic implementation plan is crucial, which includes change management.
- **Evaluate**
Have the goals been achieved? What's next? How should the results be consolidated?
