

Levels and checkpoints

The levels for *Test environments* are typified as follows:

- **Forming**: Test environments enable consistent automation execution.
- **Norming**: Test environments are continuously kept up-to-date at all test levels.
- **Performing**: Test environments support Business Process Testing.

Please find the checkpoints below.

Forming

- 1. The test environments are available for test automation when needed.
- 2. Relevant tooling can access the environments.
- 3. The test environments are reliable and enables consistent execution of automated testing.
- 4. Changes to the test environments are planned and communicated.

Norming

- 1. The test environments are continuously available.
- 2. Each automated test level is supported by the test environments.
- 3. The test environments support automated testing across applications/systems/components.
- 4. The test environments for automated testing are continuously kept up-to-date.

Performing

- 1. The test environment for testing at (user) acceptance level is production like and used for automated testing.
- 2. The validity of the test environments is regularly checked.
- 3. The test environments support automated testing across end-to-end business processes.
- 4. A mechanism to efficiently support testing in different configurations is in place (e.g. virtualization).
